Supporting information 1 : HT-GCxGC coupled by Simulated Distillation analyses of the gas oil feed and the 80% HDN conversion effluent

In order to evaluate the conversion by cracking reactions and hydrocarbon composition after hydrotreatment, the gas oil feed and the hydrotreated effluent at 79.5% HDN conversion were analyzed by high-temperature comprehensive two dimensional chromatography (HT-GCxGC) coupled with simulated distillation. The configuration of GCxGC was described as following:

Detector	FID 100Hz

Figure S1: HT-GCxGC-FID chromatogram of the 79.5% HDN conversion liquid effluent




