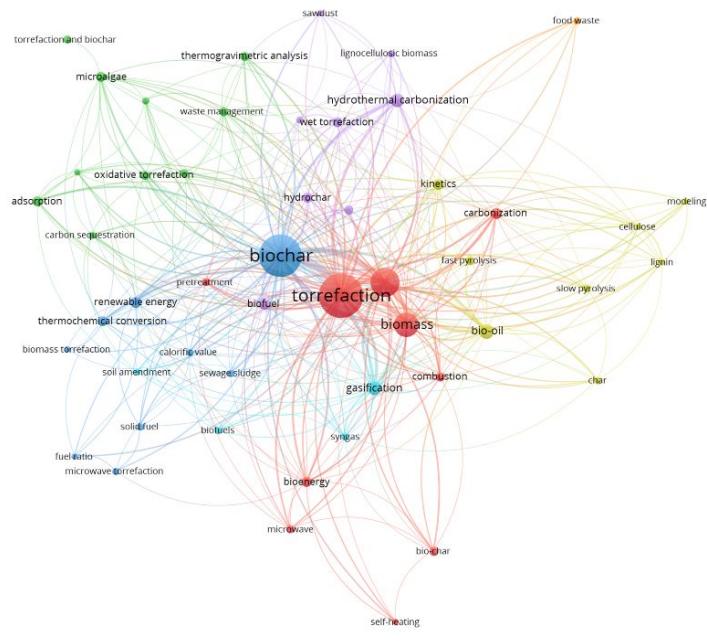

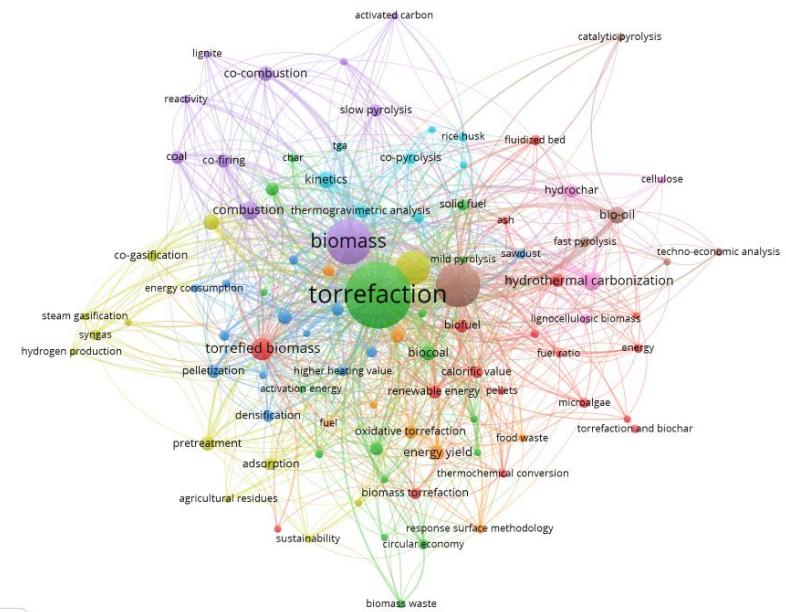
Figure S1. The co-occurrence clusters with the keywords of the selected articles from Scopus and Web of Science databases.

Figure S2. The co-occurrence clusters with the affiliations (countries) of the selected articles from Scopus and Web of Science databases.

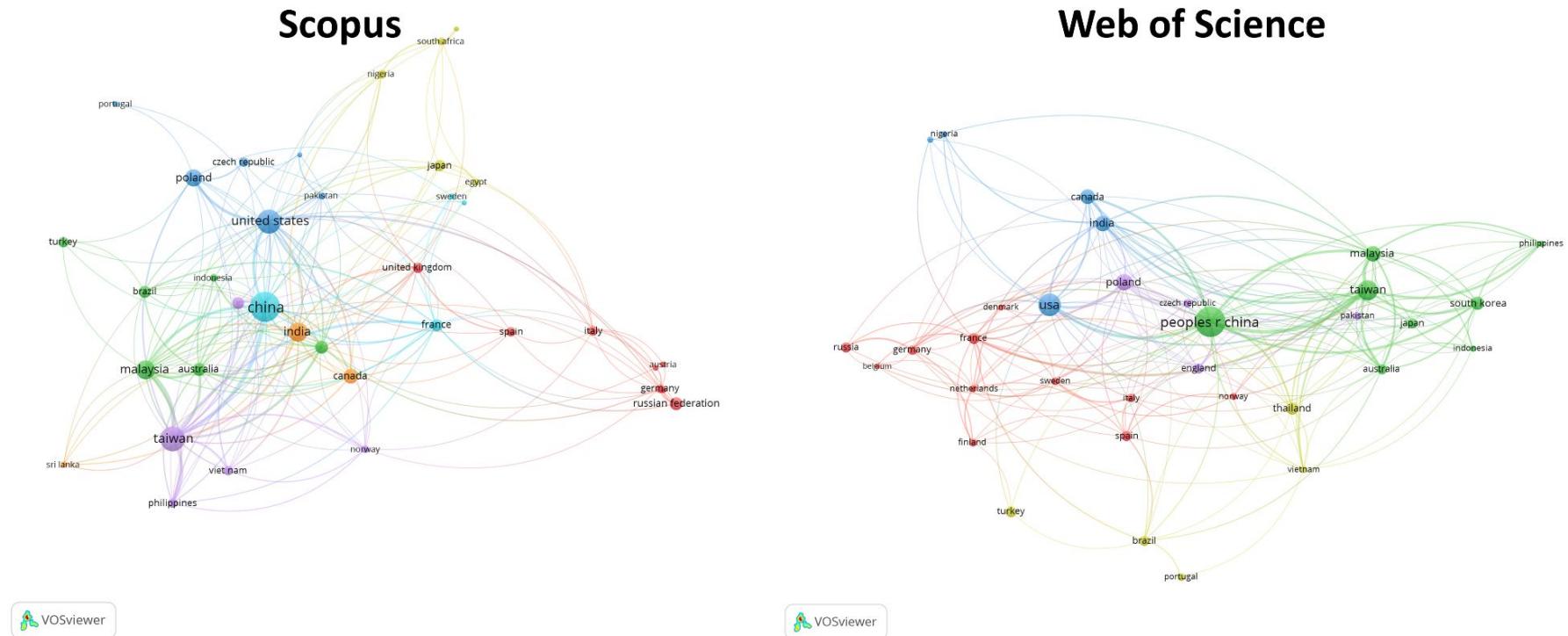
